MEMORANDUM OF ASSOCIATION

OF

SWARGA DWAR

- I. The name of Society will be "SWARGA DWAR" which for the sake of brevity is hereinafter referred to as "the Society"
- II. The Registered office of the society shall be situated in village Rohinjan, Taluka Panvel, Post Taloja, District Raighad, in the state of Maharashtra.
- III. The objects for which the Society is established are:-
  - (1) To promote, establish, found, take over, maintain, manage and conduct works of charity, medical aid and devotion to humanitarian causes and in particular to those physically and mentally diseased and handicapped and particularly those that are medically classified as stricken and in a terminal condition afflicted by the diseases of cancer , tuberculosis, leprosy, venereal and other social diseases and are discarded or rejected from their homes or by society with a view to their cure and return to their homes and society and their rehabilitation and where possible gainful employment thereafter.
  - (2) For the afore said purpose to establish hospitals, dispensaries, nursing and after care departments, mercy

(3) To serve and assist those who are diseased and/or physically handicapped or mentally afflicted and retarded, in the total task of witness and service by:-

(a) Working actively for their cure and rehabilitation back to their homes and to the society;

(b) Working actively for their welfare and training with a view to their gainful employment after cure;

(c) Providing counseling, persuasion, motivation and moral and social support for them who on account of their diseases are despised or rejected by their families and by society;

(d) Providing and conducting education and recreational activities and moral classes for their moral, social and educational uplift;

(e) Educating and training the diseased, the poor and/or the socially backward and /or those who on account of their disease and /or involvement in antisocial activities or otherwise are despised by society, in art and craft, skills and trades and to diffuse to such persons knowledge in moral, social, ethical, technical, physical, commercial, and economic

- (f) Undertaking rural development for promoting the social and economic welfare of, or the uplift of the public in any rural area and particularly the diseased and to incur any expenditure there-on.

The aforesaid shall include the promotion of the social and economic welfare or the uplift of the public in any rural area which the society considers likely to promote and assist rural development of such areas regarded as rural areas under the Income Tax Act 1961 or any other law relating to rural development for the time being in force.

- (g) aiding and helping the poor, the uneducated, downtrodden, the diseased and the unfortunate victims of vice and circumstances and those who have fallen in life materially and in morals and the socially backward and /or those who on account of their disease and/or involvement in antisocial activities or otherwise by whatever reason caused, are despised, discarded or rejected by society.

- (4) To educate the public at large about the duty to accept and serve the poor, the needy and the rejected.

RULES AND REGULATIONS  
OF  
SWARGA DWAR  
INTERPRETATION

1. In these Rules and Regulations unless there be anything in the context repugnant or inconsistent therewith:

(a) "The Society" shall mean SWARGA DWAR.

(b) "The Governing Body" shall mean the Governing Body of the Society constituted as provided by these Rules and Regulations.

(c) "The Act" shall mean the Societies Registration Act, XXI of 1860 or any modification or re-enactment thereof for the time being in force.

(d) "The Chairman" and "the Vice-Chairman" shall mean the Chairman and the Vice - Chairman respectively of the society, appointed under Rule 10."

(e) Words importing the singular number shall be deemed to include the plural and vice versa.

2. REGISTERED OFFICE

The Registered Office of the Society shall be situated in Village Rohinjan, Taluka Panvel, Post Taloja, District Raighad.

3. REGULATIONS FOR MANAGEMENT

The regulations for the management of the Society shall, subject to the provisions of the Societies Registration Act 1860, be such as are contained in these Rules and Regulations.

4. MEMBERS AND MEMBERSHIP

- (a) The members of the Society shall constitute the General Body of the Society.
- (b) The Governing Body of the Society as constituted under Rule 8 hereof shall be the first members of the Society.
- (c) The Governing Body, at its sole discretion, shall at all times be entitled to admit to membership of the Society such persons as they deem fit and proper at their absolute discretion.
- (d) The Governing Body of the Society shall be entitled to terminate the membership of any member of the society permanently or for such time or times as it thinks fit provided the Governing Body shall give a notice in writing of the said termination of not less than thirty days, to such member and for reasons for which the Governing Body shall consider at its discretion to be grave.

5. BOUND BY MEMORANDUM AND RULES AND REGULATIONS

Every member of the Society shall be bound by the provisions of the Memorandum of Association of the Society and these Rules and Regulations and by all Rules and Regulations, bye-laws and decisions from time to time made or taken by the Society in General Meeting or by the Governing Body.

6. LIST OF MEMBERS

7. TERMINATION OF MEMBERSHIP

Membership of the Society shall ipso-facto terminate if:

- (a) A member dies, or leaves, or is excluded from the Society, or permanently leaves India or
- (b) Tenders his/her resignation in writing to the Governing Body of the Society, or
- (c) His/her membership is terminated as provided by these Rules and Regulations.

8. GOVERNING BODY

The management and control of the Society shall be vested in a Governing Body consisting of not less than five members and not more than nine. The members of the Governing Body shall hold office for a term of five years and shall be elected at the Annual General Meeting of the Society held at the end of every five years. Any vacancy occurring in the Governing Body, during the said term of five years shall be filled by the Governing Body by majority of votes, and the person so appointed shall hold office until the next election of the Governing Body, but the Governing Body shall have power to act notwithstanding any vacancy in its number.

"This rule shall not be applicable to the Chairman and Vice-Chairman appointed under Rule 10."

9. FIRST GOVERNING BODY

The First Governing Body of the Society shall consist of the following persons:

- 10A. The Regional Superior of the Religious Congregation PIME (Pontifical Institute for Mission Extension), at Eluru, A.P., which sponsored and established "SWARGA DWAR", shall be, ex officio Chairman of the society, during such time as he holds the said office of the Regional Superior."
- 10B. The nominee of the Chairman, who is appointed by him to be the Director in charge of SWARGA DWAR, at Rohinjan, Taloja with overall control and responsibility thereof, shall be, ex officio Vice-Chairman of the Society, during such time as he holds the said office of Director in charge of SWARGA DWAR."
- 10C. The Chairman and in his absence the Vice-Chairman, shall preside at all Meetings of the Society and of the Governing Body. In the absence of the Chairman and of the Vice-Chairman, the members of the Society or of the Governing Body, as the case may be, present at a Meeting may elect any other member of the Governing Body, or failing such, other member of the Society as Chairman of the Meeting. The Chairman and in his absence from India, the Vice-chairman and in his absence also from India, the Secretary and Treasurer shall convene all Meetings of the Governing Body at such time or place as they may deem fit.

11. POWERS OF GOVERNING BODY

The Governing Body shall have the entire control and management of the business and affairs of the society and shall have all such powers of the society enabling them generally to carry out the objects of the Society as are by the Act required to be exercised or done by the Society in General Meeting.

The Governing Body however shall not do anything so as to conflict with or to revoke any subsisting objects of the Society. Without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing powers, the Governing Body shall, for the promotion and realization of the objects and purposes of the Society have the following powers, namely:

- (a) To employ, suspend, discharge and dismiss nurses, doctors, teachers, social workers, attendants and any other personnel or staff either for remuneration or gratuitously on such terms as the Governing Body may deem fit.
- (b) To apply for, receive and utilize any Government, Municipal or other grants or allowances in connection with any institution, work, activity or property held or conducted by the Society or otherwise and to deal with the same according to the terms thereof.
- (c) To solicit, receive, administer and use any gift, donation, subscription or foundation, in kind or money, or any other property, whether subject to any trust or not, for any of the objects of the Society and to undertake and carry out the offices, duties and functions of trustees, managers and administrators either solely or jointly with another or others for or in respect of

any gifts, donations, trusts, foundations or property, whether vested in the society or otherwise, notwithstanding that the carrying out of any such trusts may involve the exercise of powers not specifically mentioned therein.

- (d) To negotiate, and enter into any arrangements with any Government, State, university, Municipality on any other public or private authority, body or association which may seem beneficial or conducive to any of the objects of the Society.
- (e) To borrow, lend or receive money on deposit upon such terms and with or without security on all or any of the property and assets of the Society, present or future, as the Governing Body shall deem necessary or expedient.
- (f) To deposit moneys in any bank or banks either in Savings or Current Account, Fixed Deposits or accounts of any other description and to withdraw such moneys from time to time or at any time, on such terms and in such manner as the Governing Body may deem fit.
- (g) To draw, endorse, discount, and in general, deal with bills of exchange, promissory notes, cheques, bills of lading, railway receipts, registered or insured letters or parcels, postal receipts, saving certificates, dock warrants, bonds, debentures, Municipal or Port Trust Loan Notes, Stocks and Shares and other



- (h) To subscribe to or otherwise aid medical, educational, cultural, technical or other institutions or objects of a public nature which have a moral or other claim to support or aid from the Society by reason of the locality of their operations or otherwise.
- (i) To provide for the maintenance and accommodation of the members in view of their past services and of persons employed by or connected with the Society, irrespective of community, religion caste, or creed, but subject to their being approved by the Governing Body, by establishing and contributing to provident and Benefit Funds and by giving pensions, or otherwise as the Governing Body may deem fit, and this maintenance expenditure shall not be construed as a division or distribution of profits, income or dividend to the members.
- (j) To establish, maintain, or close down branches or representations of the Society in such places in India and on such terms as the Governing Body may from time to time deem necessary or expedient.
- (k) To enter into and carry out arrangements for joint working or for amalgamation with any other Association, Society or Institution having objects within or similar to the objects of the Society.
- (l) To appoint such person or persons as the Governing Body may deem fit for the purpose of representing

the Society and / or the Governing Body in any legal or other proceedings to be instituted by or against the Society and/or the Governing Body.

- (m) To appoint, remove or delegate all or any powers of the Governing Body to such committee or committees consisting of such member or members of the Governing Body and/or another or others as the Governing Body may from time to time deem necessary or expedient.
- (n) Generally to do all such other things as may be deemed by the Governing Body to be incidental or conducive to the attainment of all or any of the objects of the Society.

12. MEETING & QUORUM OF GOVERNING BODY

Meetings of the Governing Body shall be held at such times and places as the Chairman or in his absence the Vice-Chairman may from time to time determine. A quorum for a meeting of the Governing Body shall be three members personally present.

If a meeting is adjourned for want of a quorum, no quorum will be necessary for the adjourned meeting.

13. CIRCULAR RESOLUTION

A circular resolution issued by the Chairman or in his absence the Vice-Chairman on any subject which he deems urgent and signed by a majority of the members of the Governing Body, shall in all respects be a valid and binding as a resolution passed at a meeting of the Governing Body, duly convened and constituted, and such resolution shall not be deemed invalid by

reason of want of notice or any other cause whatsoever

14. POWERS OF THE SOCIETY (GENERAL BODY)

The Society is empowered generally to do all acts and things as are necessary, incidental or conducive to the attainment of its objects or any of them and to do the following in particular, in its absolute discretion:-

- (a) To raise and acquire funds and moveable property of all descriptions and to acquire immovable property of any tenure in Bombay or elsewhere in India as the needs of the society may require with or without buildings and structures by contract either by way of purchase absolutely or on lease or exchange or other form of acquisition at such rent and on such terms and conditions as the Society may agree to.
- (b) Whenever necessary to erect and construct a building or buildings or structures for the objects of the Society, and maintain them.
- (c) To provide, construct, organize, maintain, improve, alter, and conduct premises, medical facilities, equipment, and means for the propagation and advancement of the objects of the Society.
- (d) To provide residential accommodation, equipment, and maintenance either free of cost or for consideration to medical and other staff, servants, the superannuated and other connected with the

work of the society and to educate, train and equip and assist financially and otherwise in the education, training and equipment of medical and other personnel for the purpose of the Society.

- (e) To give charitable aid to and to provide for the welfare of persons employed by or connected with the Society and the dependents of such persons.
- (f) To apply for, collect, recover, receive and utilize any Government, Municipal or other grant or allowance in connection with any institutions, activity, work or property held or conducted by this Society and to deal with the same according to the terms thereof.
- (g) To accept, receive, hold, expand and administer any gift, bequest, donation or foundation in kind or money or any other property moveable or immovable whether subject to any trust or not for any of the objects of the Society.
- (h) For the purpose of the Society or any of them to borrow or raise money free of interest or at such rate of interest and on such security as may be agrees to.
- (i) To invest and deal with the monies of the Society not immediately required in such securities and in such manner as the Society may think fit.
- (j) To alienate, sell let, lease, exchange, transfer, surrender, or dispose of pledge, hypothecate or mortgage or other

immovable for the time being belonging to the Society or any of them or any part thereof at such price and upon such terms, conditions and rate of interest as the Society may think fit.

- (k) To appoint such person or persons as the Society may deem fit for the purpose of representing the Society in any legal or other proceedings to be instituted by or against the Society.
- (l) To delegate all or any powers of the Society to the Chairman and the Vice-Chairman or to any member or members of the governing body or of the Society as the Society may from time to time deem necessary or expedient.

#### 15. SECRETARY AND TREASURER

- (a) There shall be a Secretary and Treasurer of the Society who shall be appointed by the Governing Body from one among them, initially for a period of five years. The Governing Body may reappoint him for successive terms thereafter at its discretion.
- (b) The Governing Body shall be entitled for grave reasons to suspend the Secretary and Treasurer from office temporarily or to terminate and remove him from office permanently.
- (c) The secretary and Treasurer shall be in charge of the accounts, the monies and all the records of the Society.

16. ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

The Annual General Meeting of the Society shall be held in the month of **April (November)** or as near thereto as possible in each year at such time and place as the Chairman or in his absence Vice-Chairman may determine, for the following purposes:

- (a) To receive the report of the Governing Body, the accounts of the Society and its Auditors' Report for the year ended 31<sup>st</sup> December preceeding the date of the Meeting. Such accounts comprise a Balance Sheet and the Income and Expenditure Account for the said year.
- (b) To elect the eligible members of the Governing Body when their election falls due according to Rule 8.
- (c) To appoint an Auditor or Auditors and to fix his or their remuneration.
- (d) To transact any other business which may be brought forward by any member of the Governing Body or of the Society with the previous permission of the Chairman.

17. SPECIAL GENERAL MEETING

The Governing Body may call a Special General Meeting of the Society whenever in their opinion they may deem if necessary to do so, or on the requisition of not less than one third of the number of members of the Governing Body or one-tenth of the total number of members of the of the Society.

18. QUORUM

The Quorum at all General Meetings of the Society shall be one third of the members of the Society, personally present.

19. VOTING

At all Meetings of the Society or the Governing Body or any Committee every member present shall have one vote. The Chairman or the Vice-Chairman or the person presiding at the Meeting shall have a second or casting vote, in case of an equality of votes. Voting by proxy shall not be allowed.

20. NOTICE OF GENERAL MEETING

Notice of a General Meeting shall be sent by post to the address of the member registered with the Society, at least ten clear days before the date on which the Meeting is to be held. The accidental omission to give any notice to any member or members shall not invalidate any resolution passed or the proceedings held at any such meeting.

21. BANK ACCOUNT

The bank accounts shall be opened in the name of the Society and shall be operated jointly by two members of the Governing Body as may be resolved by the Governing Body, from time to time.

22. VESTING OF PROPERTY

time of the registration of the Society or later acquired, shall vest with the Governing Body of the Society for the time being and all documents relating thereto and affecting such property shall be taken and shall stand and be deemed to stand in the name of the Society.

23. APPLICATION OF PROPERTY AND INCOME

The property and income of the Society shall be applied solely towards the promotion of the objects of the Society as set forth in the Memorandum of Association and no portion thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly by way or bonus or otherwise howsoever, to the members of the Society, provided that nothing herein contained shall prevent the payment in good faith, of remuneration to any officer or employee of the Society or other person for any services actually rendered.

24. TRUST

The Society shall also be registered as a Public Trust and thereupon all the properties and assets of the Society shall be held in trust by the Trustee.

25. TRUSTEE

"The Chairman and the Vice-Chairman shall be the Trustees of the Society who shall be entitled to act jointly or severally, as the need may arise", in whom all the property and funds of the Society shall vest and in their absence any such other member of the Governing Body as may be appointed by the Governing Body in their place and stead, shall on behalf of the Society, make sign and complete all contracts, licenses, transfers



and other documents necessary to purchase, take on lease or hire or otherwise acquire, dispose of or otherwise deal with any moveable or immoveable property, of all descriptions for and on behalf of the Society.

26. DISSOLUTION

If there should be a dissolution of the Society and if at that time any property or assets whatever should remain over after the satisfaction of the debts and liabilities of the Society, the same shall not be paid to or distributed among the members of the Society, or among any of them, but shall, subject to the provisions of Sections 13 and 14 of the Societies Registration Act, 1860, be given to a society having objects similar to the objects of the Society.

27. AMENDMENTS

The Memorandum of Association of the Society and these Rules and Regulations and any Rules and Regulations hereafter made by the Society may from time to time be varied, added to or revoked, in accordance with the provisions of the Act, by a majority of not less than three-fourths of the members of the Society present at a General Meeting called for the purpose of such variations, additions or revocation, in accordance with Sections 12 and 12A of the Societies Registration Act, 1860.

28. FINANCIAL YEAR

The financial and official year of the Society shall,

29. CORRESPONDENCE & ACCOUNTS

The Secretary and Treasurer shall keep all accounts of the Society in such manner as the Governing Body may from time to time prescribe.

30. SOCIETY NON\_PROFIT ORGANISATION

The Society shall be a non-profit making organization.

31. BENEFITS OF SOCIETY OPEN TO ALL

The benefits of the Society shall be open and available to all and shall not be limited or restricted to any particular community, religion, caste, class or creed of people.
